Frequently Asked Questions

I've entered but can't now run, can I transfer my place?

Transfers are allowed up to 10 days before race day; Wednesday 25 May 2022 and all requests must be made by email to beerrace@romseyroadrunners.co.uk accompanied by the replacement runner's details:

Please note transfers from affiliated runner to unaffiliated runner (and vice versa) cannot be accommodated.

I've entered but can't now run, can I pass my place to the next person on your reserves list?

We are sorry, we don't have a reserves list.

I've entered but can't now run, can I have a refund?

We don't offer refunds. If you're unable to run, we encourage you to transfer your place - please see the note above.

I've entered but can't now run, can I defer my place to next year?

We are sorry, places cannot be deferred to next year.

If I'm ill on the day, can I give my number to someone else?

We are sorry, your number must not be worn by anyone else as this is our only identification of you.

Can I run with my child in a buggy?

Yes, runners with buggies are welcome but we ask that you start at the back of the field.

Can I run with my dog?

We are sorry, no, dogs are not allowed to run in the race.

Can I wear headphones during the race?

No, the wearing of headphones, including bone conducting is not allowed.

Can I run with my child in the fun run?

We encourage children to run on their own but understand some, particularly the very young, may want you to run with them and this is permitted.

Is there a bag drop?

There is no official bag drop but you are welcome to leave your bag, at your own risk, inside the village hall (which is by the finish).

Is there a cycle park?

You are welcome to leave your bike, at your own risk, outside the village hall.
