Minutes from 2020 AGM meeting

These were agreed to be a true and accurate record. There were no matters arising.

Review of committee reports

There were no questions or comments relating to the committee reports, which had been circulated in advance.

Membership subscription fees

Cliff explained that club finances in a strong position, bolstered by low expenditure during Covid restrictions. At a time of rising inflation, the Committee judge it unwise to reduce subscription fees, but do not wish to carry large bank balances over successive years.

The Committee's proposal is that the full annual subscription of £40 is maintained from 1 January 2023, with the discount for those not individually affiliating with England Athletics increasing to reflect EA's forthcoming increase in fees. Therefore the base annual subscription rate will reduce from £25 to £23.

Amendments to club constitution

The Committee has undertaken an end-to-end review of the club constitution to ensure that it is up to date and consistent.

The proposed changes covered:

- Reference to RRR's Inclusion Policy
- Definition of Student Member
- Removal of Honorary Member and Honorary Officer categories and clarification that Social Members pay no subscription fee
- Clarification that all membership subscription payments are due by 1 January
- Removal of reduced subscription fees for 'out of area' members
- Clarification that a member who leaves the club forfeits all membership entitlements

- Clarification that any member may nominate himself or herself as a committee member
- Members of the Committee will be reimbursed for all reasonable expenses properly incurred by them in the management of the Club
- The quorum for a General Meeting shall be fifteen percent of the current Club membership present and entitled to vote
- If, within an hour following the time appointed for a General Meeting a quorum is not present, the meeting shall stand adjourned to a time and a place agreed by the Committee
- The property of the Club, other than cash at bank, shall be kept as agreed by the Committee.
- Awards Replaced Cross-Country Race Award and Road Race Award with RR10 and CC6 award respectively, in line with our website
- Clarification that the criteria for London Marathon Club place allocation shall processed as a sequence of priorities.

All of these proposed changes were accepted and apply from immediate effect.

Ganger Farm

Julia Abab opened a discussion about the suitability of Ganger Farm as a winter venue. Its key disadvantages are that:

- The roads leading from Ganger Farm are unlit and hazardous
- The indoor meeting point is cramped and noisy
- Its location makes some of the winter routes inaccessible for groups 3 and 4.

However, it was generally agreed that Ganger Farm represents an ideal venue for summer sessions. A vote was taken, showing a clear majority in favour of moving back to Woodley Hall as the Monday evening session venue during the winter months.
