Frequently Asked Questions

I've entered but can't now run, can I transfer my place?

Yes. Transfers are allowed up to 10 days before race day; All transfer requests must be made by 22/5/2024 by email to <u>beerrace@romseyroadrunners.co.uk</u> accompanied by the replacement runner's details. Please include:

I've entered but can't now run, can I have a refund?

We don't offer refunds. If you're unable to run, we encourage you to transfer your place - please see the note above.

I've entered but can't now run, can I defer my place to next year?

We are sorry, places cannot be deferred to next year.

If I'm ill on the day, can I give my number to someone else?

We are sorry, your number must not be worn by anyone else as this is our only identification of you.

Can I run with my child in a buggy?

Unfortunately UKA rules for competition now state that the pushing of persons in any device is not permitted, so no buggies are allowed in the race.

Can I run with my dog?

We are sorry, no, dogs are not allowed to run in the race.

Can I wear headphones during the race?

For safety reasons, the use of in-ear headphones is not permitted. However, in accordance with England athletics guidelines, bone conducting headphones are allowed.

Can I run with my child in the fun run?

We encourage children to run on their own but understand some, particularly the very young, may want you to run with them and this is permitted.

Is there a bag drop?

There is no official bag drop but you are welcome to leave your bag, at your own risk, inside the village hall (which is by the finish).

Is there a cycle park?

You are welcome to leave your bike, at your own risk, outside the village hall.

Is the race run on closed roads?

There is a brief road closure for the start of the race but the rest of the course is on lanes open to traffic around Braishfield village.
