## ROAD RUNNERS

### 5 Mile Beer Race Sunday 1 June 2025, 10:00am

Start:	Braishfield cricket field, Dummers Road, Braishfield SO51 0QG
Directions:	From the A3090 Romsey to Winchester road, follow signs to Braishfield, thereafter race signs will direct you to the car park.
Parking:	<p>There is a dedicated race car park in the field adjacent to the start – please follow the marshals' directions. Please <b>do not</b> park on the roads anywhere in the village, the Wheatsheaf car park or the village hall car park.</p> <p>If the weather is very wet in the run up to the race, it may not be possible for us to use the parking field. If that is the case, alternative parking arrangements will be made, and details will be sent out to all runners by email in the week before the race.</p>
Finish:	Braishfield recreation ground, a 500m walk from the car park.
Toilets:	Portaloos and a block of urinals are available in the small field adjacent to the start. Toilets in the village hall will be open at the finish.
Registration:	<p><b>**New for 2025**</b> Your running number and chip will be available to collect from <b>Up &amp; Running</b>, at 28, The Precinct, Bournemouth Rd. Chandlers Ford, Eastleigh. SO53 2GA. Numbers will be available for collection from <b>Saturday 23 May until Saturday 1 June 2025</b>.</p> <p>Alternatively, you can collect your running number from the start field <b>from 8:30am</b> on the day of the race. The entry list will be displayed on race day by the number collection so you can find your number.</p> <p>Please complete the medical information on the back of your number. If you are collecting your number on the day, please don't forget to bring safety pins!</p> <p><b>Please note:</b> your running number will <b>not</b> be posted to you.</p>
Course:	<p>The 5 mile course has been accurately measured and certified and consists of two laps along quiet country lanes, which are narrow in places. Please bear in mind that the roads will be open to traffic and other users.</p> <p>Please <b>keep left</b> on all roads unless directed otherwise. Please <b>do not</b> cross the road at crossings until directed to do so by a marshal.</p> <p>Water will be available at approximately 3 miles and the finish.</p> <p>A map of the course is available on the website.</p>
Important Information:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>Only bone conduction headphones are permitted</b> – for your own safety</li> <li>● Cyclists and dogs <b>must not</b> accompany runners</li> <li>● Under EA rules, <b>buggies are not allowed</b> at the Beer Race</li> <li>● Your running number must not be worn by any other person, as this is our only identification of you.</li> <li>● Please follow the directions of the marshals, keeping left unless otherwise directed.</li> </ul>
Prizes:	A pint of Flack Manor beer (soft drink for under 18s), a slice of cake, for every finisher. There are prizes for the top three male and female finishers plus category winners (male and female 40, 50, 60, 70, 80). The presentation will take place at the recreation ground at approximately 11:30am.

Fun Run:	This is a 1km run which takes place in and around the Braishfield recreation ground (where the main race finishes) and does not involve public roads. The course is manned throughout by marshals. It is free to enter. Registration opens on the recreation ground at 10:15 and is open to 4-14 year olds up to a maximum of 100 runners. The race starts at 11:45 and will be preceded by a five-minute warm-up. All participants receive an edible biscuit medal.
